**BOBBY ZIRKIN, DAN MORHAIM, AND DANA STEIN FORM TEAM TO FIGHT
FOR EDUCATION, PUBLIC SAFETY, JOBS, AND THE ENVIRONMENT**

Pikesville, MD (JUNE 18, 2013) – Senator Bobby Zirkin and Delegates Dan Morhaim and Dana Stein officially announced plans to team up for the 2014 election cycle. The trio campaigned together in 2010, and they have brought their collaborative approach to the General Assembly to fight for issues important to the 11th District. This latest announcement carries on a 20-year plus tradition of 11th District public officials working and campaigning together to make Northwest Baltimore County one of the best places to raise a family in Maryland.

“We are facing serious issues in Maryland – including overcrowded schools,

escalating medical costs and health care disparities, environmental threats, street violence and other public safety concerns. Residents of the 11th District deserve to have a strong, cohesive team on their side,” said Zirkin.

Dan Morhaim also stressed the importance of unity: “It’s critical that we all work toward the same goals to serve our constituents most effectively. That starts on the campaign trail.”

“Over the coming months, we look forward to talking about legislative priorities and introducing ourselves to the new parts of the 11th District,” said Stein. “As colleagues we each bring distinctive strengths to the team – it is together that we are best able to serve the 11th District.”

Mr. Zirkin is the founding member and owner of a growing law practice in Owings Mills representing clients from all over the State. A respected advocate for children, Mr. Zirkin introduced groundbreaking legislation in the House of Delegates to reduce class sizes, reform child welfare, and improve summer education for at-risk youth. Elected to the Senate in 2006, he continues to serve as a fierce advocate for Maryland’s schools and the foremost advocate for juvenile service reform in the state. As one of the Senate’s practicing attorneys, Zirkin has also emerged as a leader on important issues such as criminal justice, civil and family law, and consumer protection. His legislative accomplishments include expanding Maryland’s sex offender registry, passing scores of juvenile justice laws, and making progress in the areas of drunk driving and domestic violence.

Dr. Morhaim is the only physician in the 188-member Maryland legislature. As Deputy Majority Leader, Morhaim is highly respected by both parties as a legislator who builds consensus and gets things done. He passed pioneering reforms to increase school resources, expand access to quality healthcare, streamline state government, encourage minority and women-owned businesses, improve worker safety, and promote green initiatives. Morhaim also serves on the faculty at the Johns Hopkins University and the University of Maryland and literally wrote the book on how to improve the way we approach end of life decision-making in America. His book, “The Better End,” is a guide for families, caregivers, and public officials.

Mr. Stein founded and leads Civic Works, an “urban Peace Corps” that has served Baltimore for 20 years by transforming the lives of young adults through community service. As a Delegate, Stein established the Task Force on Improving Financial Literacy leading to the adoption of financial literacy curriculum in public schools. He fought to protect the environment by creating the Maryland Clean Energy Center and passing a law authorizing the use of the International Green Construction Code. Stein was also instrumental in passing legislation to improve child safety seat standards and help veterans transition to private sector employment. Stein also is an

adjunct professor at the University of Baltimore and an attorney.
